

The 30th Avenue School Seeks Teaching Assistants for Kindergarten to 4th Grade classes

The 30th Avenue School (Q300) is a city-wide G&T public school located in the heart of Astoria, Queens. Our school is an active and engaged community with diverse learners spanning kindergarten to 8th grade. Our mission is centered around three core values: Inclusion, Inquiry and Responsibility which drives our agile approach to education – teaching a curriculum with models of differentiation and personalization. There is high engagement in the school, allowing staff, parents, guardians, and students to continue making positive impacts to education and the Q300 experience.

Q300 is seeking teacher assistants to support classes from grades Kindergarten to 4th Grades from September 11, 2023 to June 26, 2024.

Job Responsibilities:

- Build rapport with classroom teacher and students in assigned class or classes
- Support teacher in daily duties including but not limited to, preparing and setting up activities, grading, organizing, filing, etc.
- Support students in small groups throughout the day in multiple subjects (English Language Arts, Math, Science, etc.)
- Assist and supervise students during recess, lunch, arrival, dismissal, and bus drop-off and pick-up at school.
- Work as a team to support the needs of the school building and community

Development:

If hired, candidate will benefit from the following:

- Experience in the classroom with elementary school-aged children
- Experience with teachers and staff working with a range of diverse learners
- Experience and observation of different methods of teaching and support such as differentiation or personalization
- Implementation of ASPIRE as an in-school expectation and behavioral model

Qualifications:

- Experience working with students between ages of 5 years old to 10 years old
- Background knowledge in social emotional learning and supporting a positive classroom environment
- Minimum of 2 years in college or an Associate Degree
- Working toward a degree in Education (*Preferred not required*)
